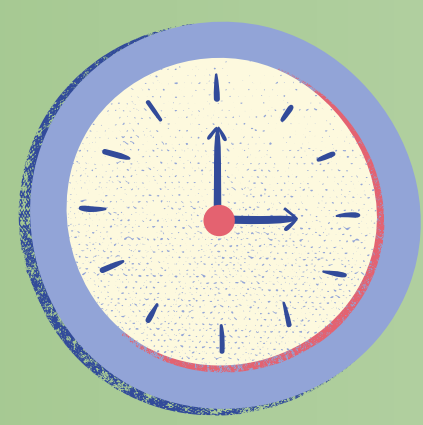

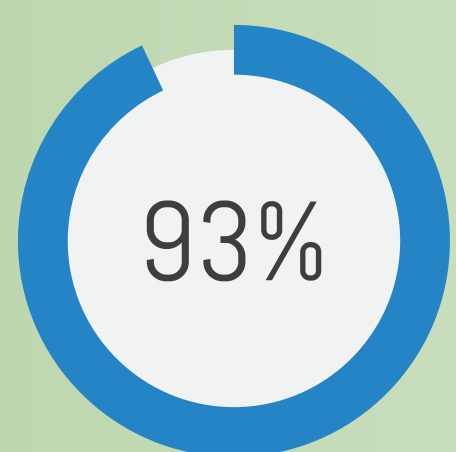
Our ultimate goal of 'move-on' is achieved through our nurturing operations, allowing Young People in our care to achieve independence...

CAYSH's specialist projects, like Working My Way Up and Your Voice Your Choice, support development and wellbeing.

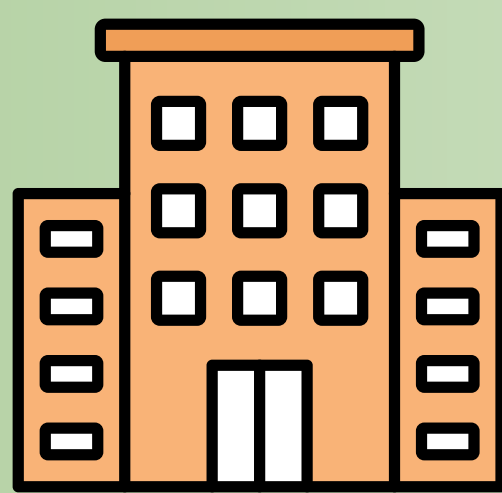


Supporting everyone! In 2022-2023, we served 52% from ethnic minority groups, 26% White British, and 22% from mixed or other backgrounds.
